#### STUDIO SPACES

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A range of studio hire options are available at the Studio One Toi Tū precinct. Studio One Toi Tū is a hub for creatives and community activities, where designers, writers, artists, performers, musicians and other creative people can make and collaborate. We have a range of studio options and are one of the few precincts in Auckland to offer access to a 'dirty' workshop suitable for ceramicists, sculptors and object makers. We also offer a number of open studio spaces that can be hired individually or collectively for making, meetings, workshops or temporary events. We are located in the heart of central Auckland with free Wi-Fi, kitchen facilities and the possibility for 24 hour access. Call us on 09 376 3221 to find out how we can support you.

#### THE CELL BLOCK

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The Cell Block studio spaces are private studios available for hire at a rate of \$78 per week. It comes with 24 hour access and is hired on a monthly basis.

#### VIIIA STUDIO

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A 'dirty' shared studio space with access to the sculpture workshop, kiln and prep room and is available for hire at a rate of \$175 per week. It comes with 24 hour access and is hired on a monthly basis.

#### KILN HIRE

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Studio One Toi Tū has two kilns for bisque and glaze firing. These can be hired out for individuals or community groups for the firing of their own ceramic works.





On opening night expect a re-configured roaming performance of their debut contemporary dance work *Desire Line(s)*, bringing alive the walls and pockets in and around historic Studio One Toi Tū.

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# CELL BLOCK PORTRAITS & (SUB)URBAN LANDSCAPES


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Stjohn Milgrew is a photographer and director whose practice focuses on documentary film. He is currently exploring his passion for vintage film photography.

Weather and time have created an atmosphere of quiet in the sliding decay.

Patmore's work also tests the concept of value – the idea that something once deemed as rubbish can become important with a small shift in perception.




